**SUBJECT:** Projected Revenue from HUTF Off-the-Top Distributions for FY 2012-13

This memorandum summarizes off-the-top distributions projected to be available from the Highway Users Tax Fund (HUTF) in FY 2012-13. Appended is an overview of the HUTF off-the-top distributions currently projected for FY 2012-13 (Attachment A). Based on current projections, there will be about \$14.1 million available to fund capital construction projects from off-the-top distributions this year.

# **Background**

HUTF off-the-top appropriations fund the capital and operating expenses associated with the Department of Revenue, Ports-of-Entry Division, and Department of Public Safety, Colorado State Patrol.<sup>1</sup> Revenue accrues to the HUTF from the state motor fuel tax, vehicle registration fees, drivers' license fees, and court fines. Off-the-top distributions are funded from the motor fuel tax, which is divided into two pots prior to distribution: the first 7 cents of the tax rate and everything else above 7 cents.

Off-the-top distributions are made from revenue received from the first 7 cents of the motor fuel tax rate. After off-the-top distributions are made, the remainder of the revenue above the first 7 cents is distributed 65 percent to the Colorado Department of Transportation, 26 percent to counties, and 9 percent to cities.<sup>2</sup>

Off-the-top distributions are limited to 6 percent growth over the prior year's appropriation. For example, in FY 2012-13, the projected appropriation limit is \$129.7 million, 6 percent more than the FY 2011-12 expected expenditure of \$122.4 million. To date, only \$110.8 million of the available \$122.4 million for FY 2011-12 has been appropriated. Staff anticipates that the remaining available FY 2011-12 balance of \$11.6 million will be requested and appropriated through the regular supplemental process.

### FY 2012-13 Projections

Assuming that the remainder of the available FY 2011-12 off-the-top moneys are fully expended, the FY 2012-13 operating requests for the departments of Public Safety and Revenue, as projected by Joint Budget Committee (JBC) staff, plus the requested funding for FY 2012-13 capital projects for the Department of Revenue's ports-of-entry operations, is under the available 6 percent growth limit by about \$11.8 million. If no further appropriations are made from the remaining FY 2011-12 off-the-top balance, thus reducing the base for FY 2012-13, the FY 2012-13 off-the-top appropriations limit will be \$117.4 million, leaving the FY 2012-13 capital projects underfunded by about \$0.5 million.

## **Committee Action Required**

Assuming that a sufficient portion of the available FY 2011-12 off-the-top moneys are appropriated, the Capital Development Committee may choose to recommend funding for the four ports-of-entry projects requested by the Department of Revenue as part of its cash-funded recommendation to the JBC.

If no further appropriations are made during the regular supplemental process from the remaining FY 2011-12 HUTF off-the-top balance, the FY 2012-13 appropriations limit will be \$117,438,849, which will result in a shortfall of \$458,146 for the total FY 2012-13 operating and capital request.
