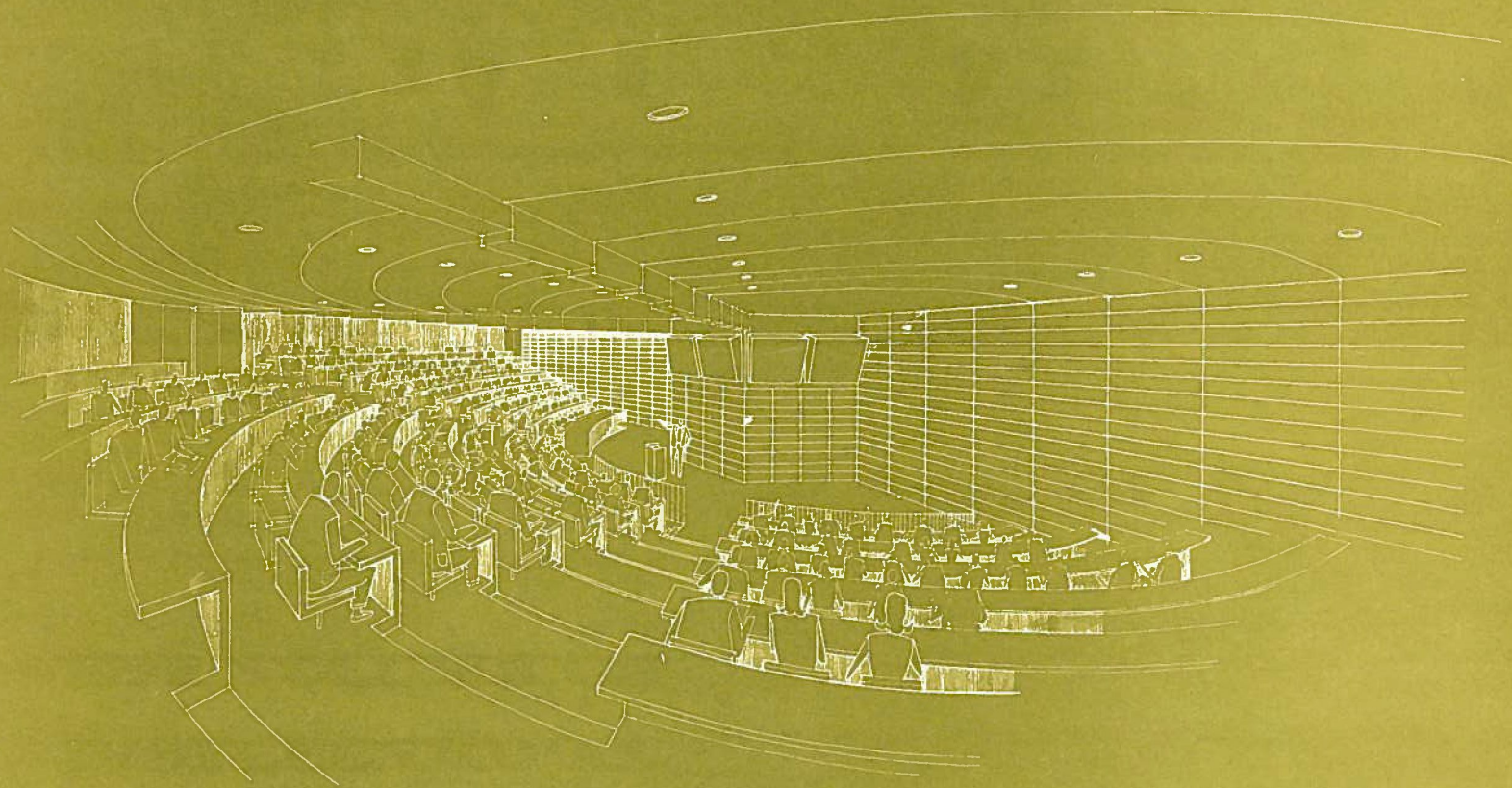

INTRODUCTION

This report includes data on all resident classes taught at the public institutions of higher education in Colorado during the 1968-69 academic year and the 1969 summer session. Excluded from the report are data for the Medical Center of the University of Colorado and off-campus extension courses for all institutions. Summer session data for Colorado State University and the Colorado Springs Center of the University of Colorado were not reported to the Commission.

The reader should be aware that the University of Colorado and the Colorado School of Mines operate on the semester system; Fort Lewis College and Colorado Mountain College operate on the trimester system; while all other institutions operate on the quarter system. All data in this report have been converted to a quarter-hour basis.

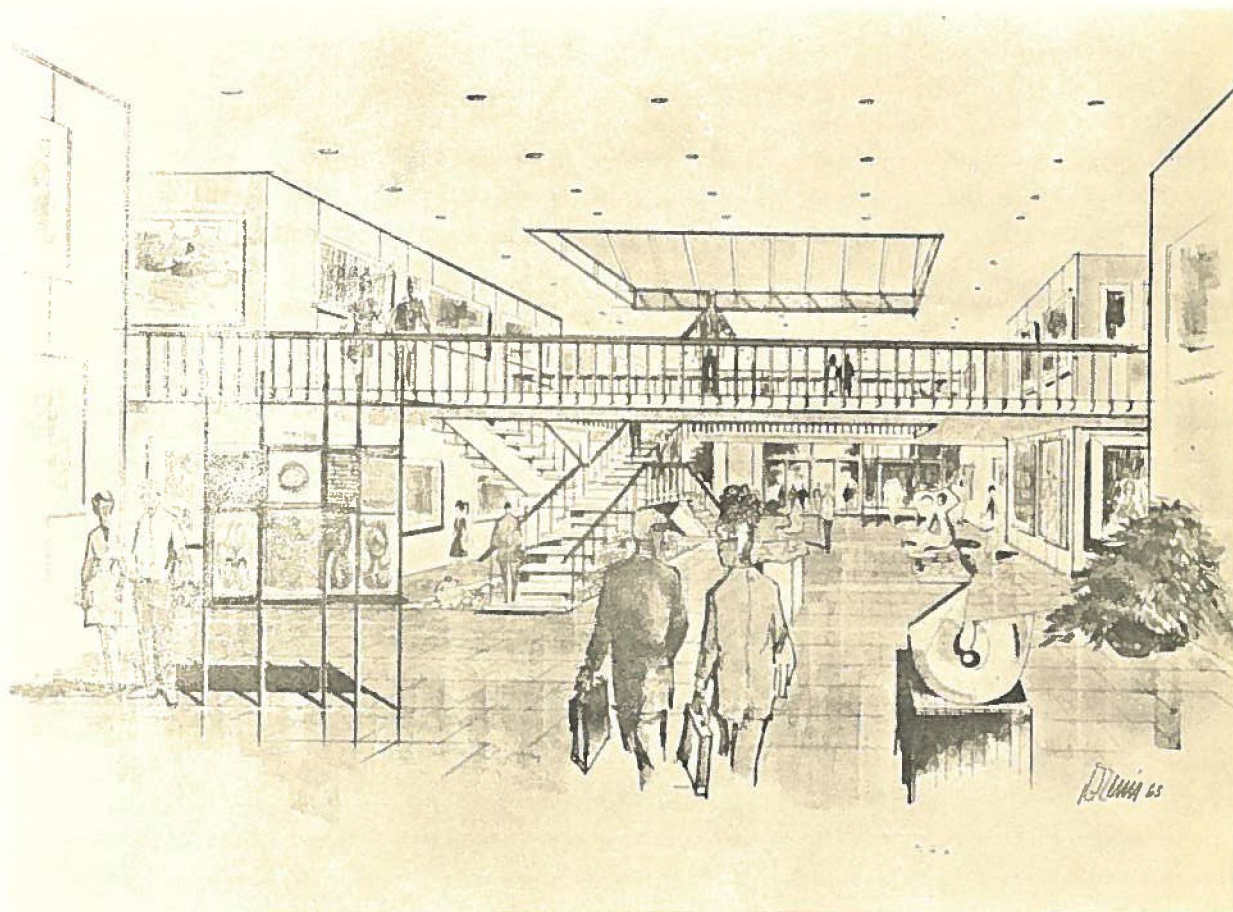
Data presented in this report have been classified according to 36 subject fields adapted from the United States Office of Education classification system. This classification system was utilized as an attempt to discover, in the most objective way possible, the number of student-credit-hours produced in the various subject fields, based upon the content of the individual courses. No attempt was made to adhere to the departmental organization of the various institutions in classifying courses by subject field.

Those courses which were not taught in the traditional classroom or laboratory situation are classified separately as (a) courses taught by television, (b) student teaching or field supervision courses, (c) thesis or dissertation courses, or (d) independent study courses. These kinds of courses are referred to in this report as "special" courses while those taught in traditional classroom or laboratory settings are referred to as "regular" courses. The special courses are presented only in total in this report, rather than by instructional levels and subject fields.

Student-credit-hours produced in "regular" classes are reported according to level of students enrolled in the courses regardless of the course level. With respect to level of students, lower level students are those classified by the institution as freshmen or sophomores on the basis of total accumulated hours in the programs in which they are enrolled. Upper level students are those students classified by the institution as juniors or seniors on the basis of total accumulated hours in the program in which they are enrolled. First-year graduate students are those holding a bona fide bachelor's degree, but not a master's degree (or its equivalent by institutional criteria) who has been admitted to the graduate college or division as a candidate for either an advanced degree or certificate. Students enrolled in the first year of professional programs in law or veterinary medicine are considered as first-year graduate students. Advanced graduate students are those holding a bona fide master's degree, or its equivalent, who have been admitted to the graduate college or division as candidates for advanced degrees or certificates beyond the master's degree. Students enrolled in the second and succeeding years of professional programs in law and veterinary medicine are considered advanced graduate students.

THE COMMISSION IS CHARGED WITH DEVELOPING LONG-RANGE PLANS FOR AN EVOLVING STATE PROGRAM OF HIGHER EDUCATION; WITH THE REVIEW OF OPERATING AND CAPITAL BUDGET REQUESTS OF THE COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES AND RECOMMENDATION TO THE GOVERNOR AND JOINT BUDGET COMMITTEE OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AS TO PRIORITIES FOR FUNDING; WITH REVIEW AND DECISION RELATING TO PROPOSED NEW DEGREE PROGRAMS IN ANY OF THE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION; WITH RECOMMENDATION TO THE GOVERNOR AND JOINT BUDGET COMMITTEE ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF STATE-SUPPORTED INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION; AND WITH STUDY AND RECOMMENDATION IN OTHER AREAS OF PROGRAMMING AT THE POST-SECONDARY LEVEL. THE COMMISSION SERVES AS STATE AGENCY FOR ADMINISTRATION OF TITLE I OF THE HIGHER EDUCATION FACILITIES ACT OF 1963 AND SEVERAL TITLES OF THE HIGHER EDUCATION ACT OF 1965.
