HOW TO SPOT AN IMPAIRED DRIVER

- 1. Appearing to be drunk (e.g. eye fixation, face close to windshield, drinking in the vehicle.)
- 2. Turning with a wide radius
- 3. Almost striking an object or car
- 4. Weaving, swerving or drifting
- 5. Driving significantly under the speed limit for no obvious reason
- 6. Braking erratically or stopping without cause
- 7. Accelerating rapidly
- 8. Tailgating
- 9. Straddling the center of the lane or driving with the left tires on the center line
- 10. Responding slowly to traffic signals
- 11. Turning abruptly or illegally
- 12. Driving at night with headlights off

If you see someone driving like this, call Star-DUI (*384) or Star-CSP (*277) from a cellular phone.

Give the dispatcher the exact location (road and direction), a description of the vehicle, and the manner in which the vehicle is being driven. Do not attempt to follow or pursue the vehicle.

Your call is free and may save a life -- or many lives!
