NEW JOBS INCENTIVE CASH FUND

The Colorado Economic Development Commission (EDC) has oversight responsibilities for this fund which provides performance-based incentive payments to qualifying companies that through business development, business expansions and/or relocations have created net new jobs throughout the state. During 2010, the EDC received 10 applications from 7 businesses which were awarded incentives in the amount of \$2,401,646 for the creation of 702 net new full-time positions. The chart below summarizes the 10 applications received by the EDC.
