

When you sit down to a meal of freshly caught trout, locally raised striped bass or Colorado's celebrated lamb-whether by candlelight or campf re light-a glass of Colorado's elegant Rieslings or complex Cabernets makes the perfect complement. Colorado wines have their own distinct character and f avors-thev don't taste like any other place. They taste uniquely like our Beautiful State of Wine.

Colorado's abundant sunshine, warm days, cool nights, and low humidity provide the perfect conditions for wine grapes that feature the complex character and chemistry required to craft award-winning wines. Colorado's close to 100 wineries, all small, family-owned estates, have earned a well-deserved reputation for premium wines and consistently win top national and international awards.

The federal government has designated two regions in Colorado as American Viticultural Areas (AVA), which identify unique geographic and climactic features that distinguish the qualities of a region's grape-growing. The **Grand Valley AVA**, including Grand Junction and Palisade, straddles the Colorado River just east of the Utah border. The **West Elks AVA** surrounds Paonia and Hotchkiss along the North Fork of the Gunnison River, in the shadow of the West Elk Mountains.

Most of Colorado's wine grapes come from these two areas, as well as vineyards in Delta, Montrose, Fremont, Larimer, Kit Carson, and Montezuma counties.

If you aren't enjoying Colorado wines right now, sit beside a bubbling mountain stream or gaze up at the snow-capped peaks and consider *changing your state of wine!*



# FRONT RANGE WINE TRAIL

The Front Range Wine
Trail, shooting out on short
side trips from the I-25
corridor, contains three
dozen wineries and tasting
rooms from the iconic Castle
Rock, north through Denver
and Boulder, to Estes Park,
gateway to Rocky Mountain
National Park.

# ROCKY MOUNTAIN WINE TRAIL

Georgetown, the beginning of the Rocky Mountain Wine Trail, is less than an hour's drive due west from Downtown Denver on I-70. On this trail you pass through enchanting Victorian mining and railroad towns (Georgetown, Minturn, Fairplay, and Leadville) as well as ski resorts (Winter Park and Dillon). Wineries at this altitude may not be able to grow grapes or fruit, but they serve their samples beside other diversions such as world-class skiing and snowboarding, whitewater rafting, and crystal clear mountain air. From Dillon you can head south through Breckenridge over Hoosier Pass to the Pikes Peak/ Arkansas Valley Wine Trail via CO Hwy 9 and US Hwys 24 and 285.





# **HEART OF COLORADO WINE COUNTRY TRAIL**

Between some of the world's greatest mountain biking trails in Fruita, climbing the Colorado National Monument and hiking through the Black Canyon of the Gunnison National Park, the Heart of Colorado Wine Country, encompassing two federally designated American Viticultural Areas (AVA), offers some of the grandest scenery in North America.

First, the Grand Valley AVA follows I-70 along the Colorado River beginning in Palisade (look for the Palisade Fruit and Wine Byway signs) to the foot of the spectacular Colorado National Monument just west of Grand Junction. Heading south on US Highway (Hwy) 50 from there, the wine explorer can continue a dozen miles past Delta to visit the wineries near Olathe, sweet corn capital of the world.

The Heart of Colorado Wine Country Trail turns east at Delta onto CO Hwy 92 following the Gunnison River. You can veer north at CO



Hwy 65 to visit the wineries along Surface Creek, on the south slope of Grand Mesa, the largest f attop mountain in the world. The scenic byway across the top of Grand Mesa (with more than 300 lakes stocked with very hungry f sh) is one of the most beautiful drives imaginable. This byway

loops back to I-70, just east of the Grand Valley AVA.

# COLORADO WINE TRAILS







Continuing due east on CO Hwy 92 shadowing the Gunnison River, you reach Hotchkiss where you bear north along the North Fork of the Gunnison. Here you enter the West Elks AVA, named for the surrounding mountains. From Hotchkiss, you can visit the Black Canyon of the Gunnison National Park by following CO Hwy 92 or take CO Hwy 133 through Paonia and over McClure Pass into Redstone and Carbondale. A right turn at Carbondale puts you in Aspen. A left turn takes you to Glenwood Springs, with the world's largest hot springs pool, and there you rejoin the Rocky Mountain Wine Trail on I-70.

# **FOUR CORNERS REGION**

For a full dose of Colorado history and scenery, start at Durango, home to the famous narrow-gauge steam railway, then head west to Cortez and the Four Corners region near Mesa Verde National Park. Here ancient pottery shards and Ancestral Puebloan ruins are mixed in with the vineyards.

# PIKES PEAK AND THE ARKANSAS VALLEY REGION

If you f nd yourself in the Pikes Peak area around Colorado Springs or in the Arkansas River Valley near Pueblo, a dozen wineries are within 100 miles. Sip on some wine after you raft the Arkansas Headwaters in Salida. Or if you're brave enough to explore the world's highest suspension bridge at the Royal Gorge Bridge and Park, the wineries in Cañon City can quench your thirst. Closer to Colorado Springs, enjoy a glass of local wine or mead at one of the wineries in historic Cripple Creek, quaint Mantiou Springs, or a Woodland Park art gallery. Head north on I-25 to the Front Range Wine Trail or through the storied San Luis Valley (US Hwy 285) to the Four Corners Region.
