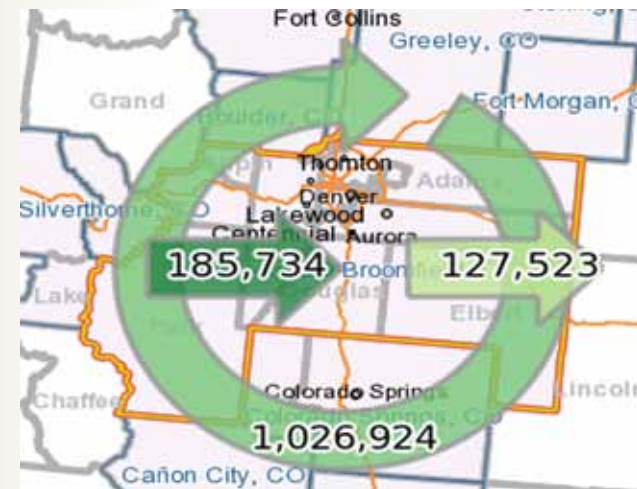


Worker Inflow and Outflow

These reports include the larger population of workers coming into and leaving from Denver MSA

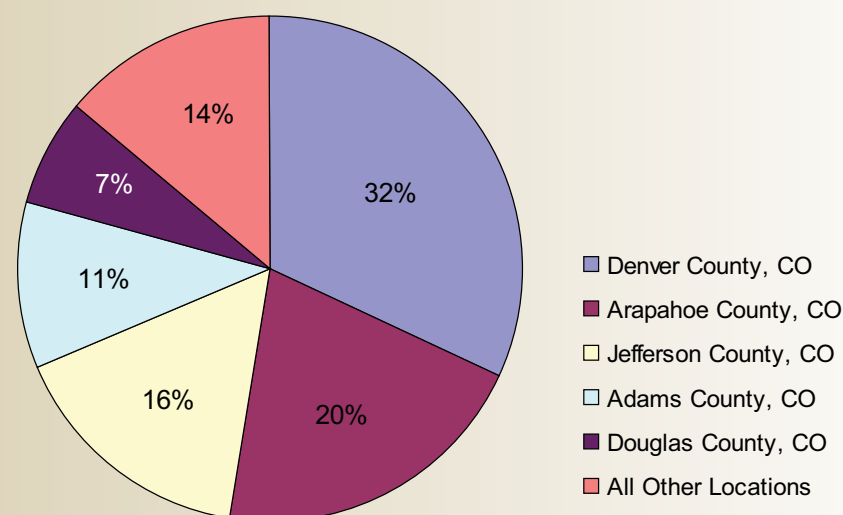
Note: overlay arrows do not indicate directionality of worker flow between home and employment locations.

- ➡ Live in Selection Area, Employed Outside

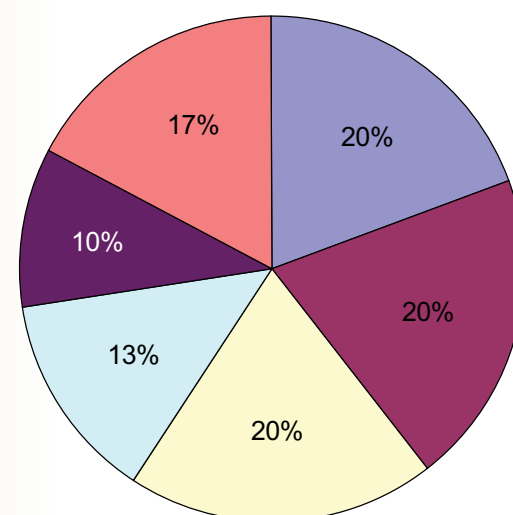

On The Map is a unique resource for identifying workforce characteristics within specific geographic areas and mapping the commuting patterns of workers. LED can answer questions as diverse as:

- How many people work and live in my geographic area?
- How many people work in my geographic area and live outside?
- How many people live in my geographic area and work outside?
- What distance and direction do commuters take to get to/from my area?
- How might I characterize workers in my area: age, earnings, race, educational attainment, gender, industry distribution?

Colorado LED is a partnership between the Office of Labor Market Information and the U.S. Census Bureau. LED is sometimes referred to as Longitudinal Employer-Household Dynamics (LEHD).

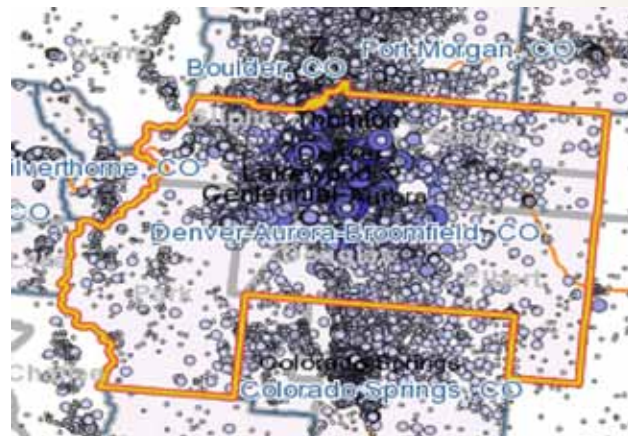

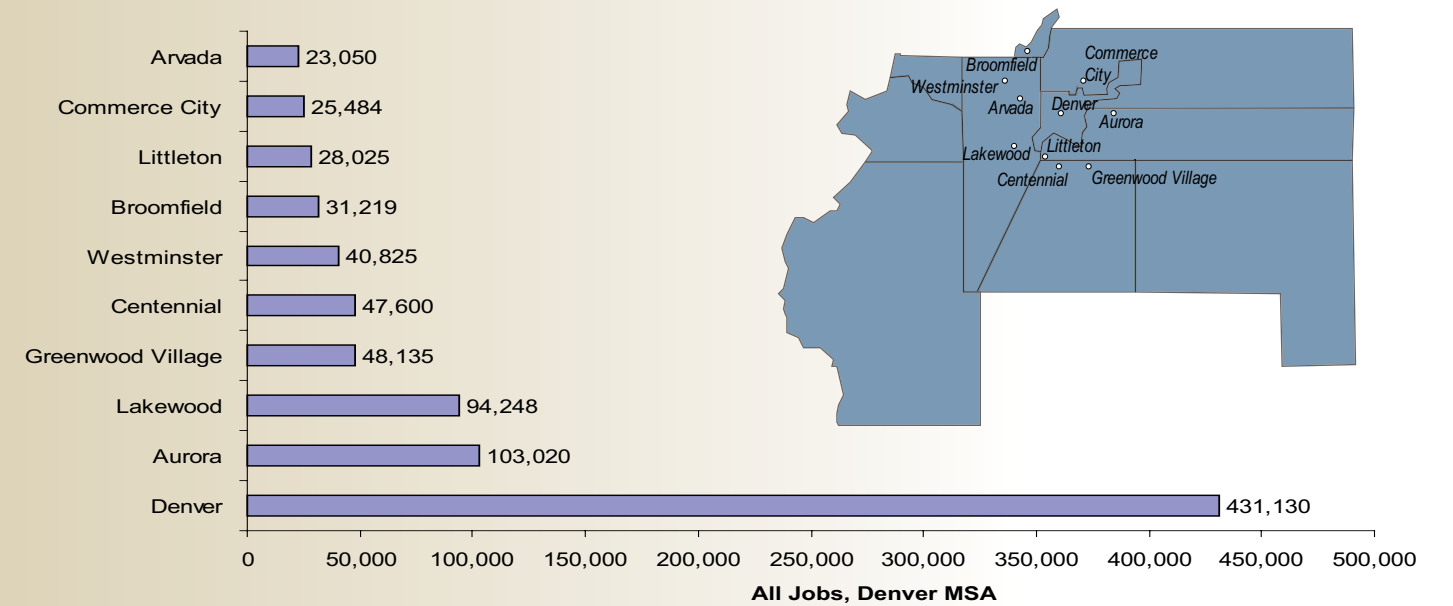

Area Comparison Report

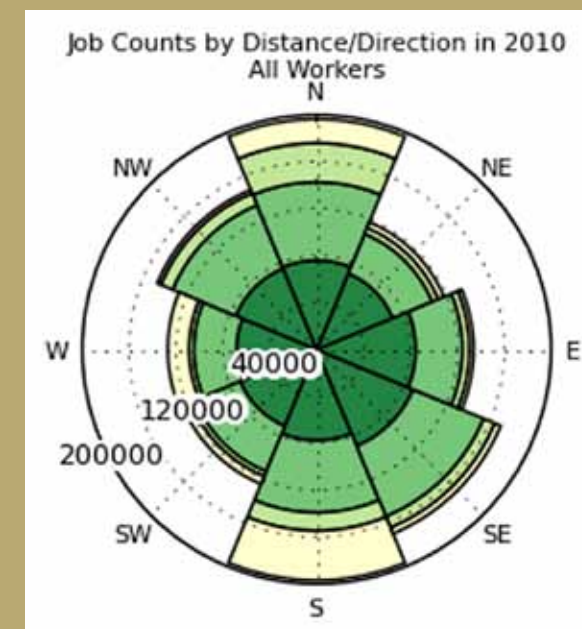

Distance - Direction Report

Looking at only those workers employed in Denver MSA, this report aggregates jobs by the distance and direction of the worker's commute, as the crow flies, from home to work.

The default display on this Report is the "radar chart" shown below. If you prefer, it can easily be changed to display in a more conventional bar chart.

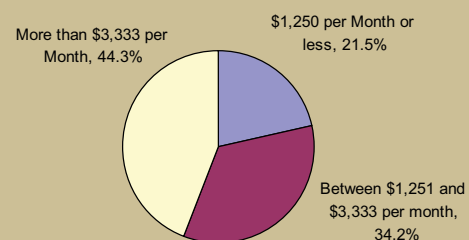


Jobs by Distance - Work to Home

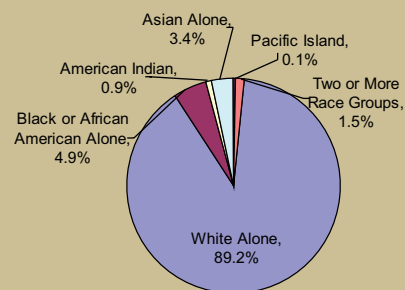

The LED business location data include both workers at the business physical location and workers who primarily work from home and only occasionally commute to the workplace. These differences are not distinguishable in the data.
