LMI Gateway is an online resource for the latest in labor market information and employer assistance to customers, staff, analysts, and researchers.

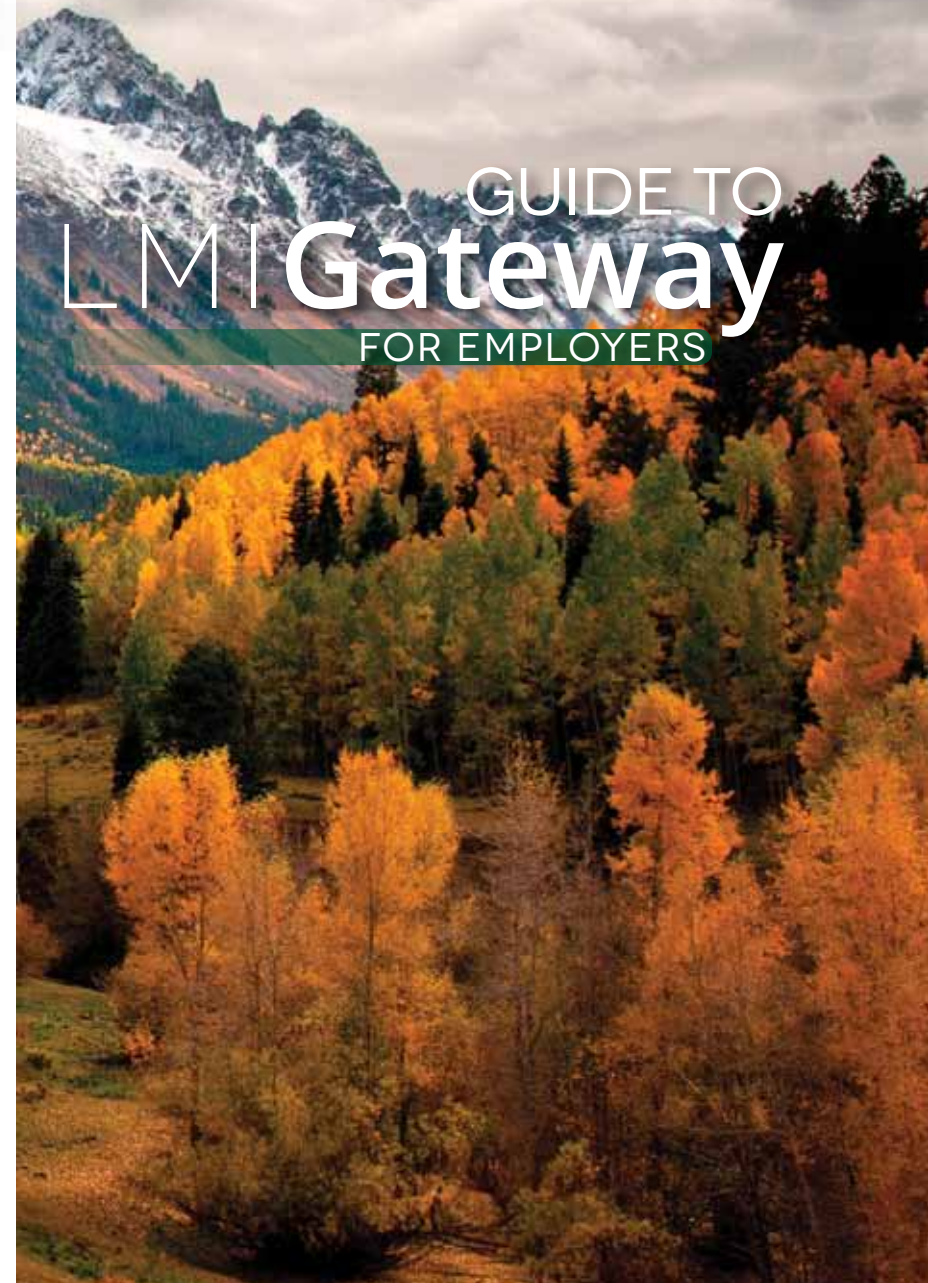
