



POINTERS FOR PREPARING A FILING

OVERVIEW

The following information serves as a guide for making filings with the Commission, including a mock-up filing with notable requirements indicated in red.

For specific guidance on filing requirements, always consult the [Commission's rules](#) for specific filing requirements.

ADMINISTRATIVE REJECTION

The Commission conducts its proceedings “in such manner as will best conduce the proper dispatch of business and the ends of justice” allow. This requires the Commission to “administratively reject” filings that do not comply with the rules. For example, Rule 1305(b) of the Rules of Practice and Procedure allows the Commission to reject any proposed tariff, price list, or time schedule that is not submitted in the format required by the Commission’s rules.

When filing documents with information claimed to be confidential or highly confidential, please take special care to make a public filing with the confidential information redacted. Failure to do so requires Commission staff to administratively reject the filing pursuant to Rule 1101(a).

FILING CHECKLIST

Number of copies

- If a filing is submitted electronically through the [Commission's E-Filing System](#), no copies of the filing are made.
- When filed in paper, the Original +3 copies should be submitted, except for annual reports. For annual reports, the Original + 2 copies should be filed.

General content

- Clear and concise statement of authority relied upon
- Clear and concise statement of relief sought
- The name, including trade name, if any, of the party or the party’s attorney

General formatting requirements

- 8.5” x 11” white pages (for pleadings other than pre-printed forms)
- One-inch margins
- Bound with removable bindings
- Page number centered at bottom center of each page excluding the cover page. Written testimony page numbers may be included in a header.
- Text at least 12-point type
- Double-spaced (indented quotations and footnotes may be single-spaced)

Pleading caption must contain the following:

- The heading “Before the Public Utilities Commission of the State of Colorado.”
- Proceeding title. For applications and petitions, the title must contain the following:
 - Applicant’s/petitioner’s name
 - Description of the specific order sought
 - Brief description of the proceeding’s subject matter
 - If related to previous proceeding, identification of the previous proceeding by number
- Proceeding number
- Pleading title

Multiple documents filed as a single filing (e.g., an application with a related motion, a motion with exhibits, or an advice letter with related tariff pages)

Through E-Filings: primary and secondary documents must be

- Separately identified
- Separately uploaded

Paper filings: primary document and each secondary document must be

- Separately identified
- Separated with blank slip sheets

Requirements for all pleadings other than written testimony

- No longer than 30 pages, excluding attachments. In calculating page length, the following are not included:
 - Cover sheet
 - Table of contents
 - Certificate of mailing
 - Copies of authorities cited
 - Copies of a decision that may be the subject matter of the pleading
- Attorney signature (for parties represented by an attorney). Pleading must also include the attorney’s ...
 - Address
 - Telephone number
 - E-mail address
 - Attorney registration number
- Signed by a person with authority to bind the party (for parties not represented by an attorney). Pleading must also include that person’s ...
 - Title
 - Address
 - Telephone number
 - E-mail address

Special requirements for written testimony

- Table of contents (if testimony exceeds 20 pages and deals with more than one subject)
- Each line serially numbered in the left margin, beginning with “1” on each page

Cover sheet requirements:

- Proceeding number
- Proceeding caption
- Witness name
- Name of party for whom witness is testifying
- Date testimony is filed
- Whether testimony is direct, answer, cross-answer, rebuttal, surrebuttal, or other testimony

Exhibit requirements:

- Numbered sequentially
- Physically contained in same document as testimony if exhibit does not exceed 30 pages. If exhibits are submitted through E-Filings instead, they must be numbered sequentially and separately uploaded as secondary documents to primary written testimony.
- If exhibit is longer than 30 pages, exhibit must be bound and separated from testimony.
- Exhibits of each witness numbered sequentially beginning with the witness' initials and followed by the exhibit number.

Every pleading must have a caption identifying the proceeding title, number, pleading title, and the heading "Before the Public Utilities Commission of the State of Colorado."

Application or petition titles must contain the applicant's or petitioner's name, describe the specific order sought, and briefly describe the proceeding's subject matter. Applications/petitions related to prior proceedings must identify the prior proceeding by number.

If filed testimony exceeds 20 pages and deals with more than one subject, the filed testimony must contain a table of contents. Multiple documents filed as a single paper filing must be separately identified and separated with slip sheets.

Double-spaced, min. 12-point type. Indented quotations and footnotes may be single-spaced.

Page number centered at bottom center of each page excluding the cover page. Written testimony page numbers may be included in a header.
