The Adoption Exchange is a non-profit 501(c)(3) child welfare organization that was founded in 1983 to help establish safety and permanence in the lives of foster children. Although the Exchange was initially an exchange point for caseworkers to discuss placement of children with families seeking to adopt in the Rocky Mountain region, the organization has grown considerably over the years and engenders a powerful impact on national trends in child welfare, employs over 50 paid staff, and counts on scores of volunteers to carry out its mission. The Adoption Exchange takes a holistic approach to adoption and provides expertise and support before, during, and after the adoption process. Assistance includes the following:

- Guiding adoptive families through every phase of the adoption process.
- Educating families on the critical steps necessary to start the adoption process.
- Reviewing the steps to take while the family waits and answering any and all questions that may arise.
- Supporting families after adoption through support groups and training sessions.

The Resource Exchange (TRE) was founded by parents and families of children and adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) in 1964. It is a Colorado non-profit organization designated by the Colorado The Resource Exchange Department of Health Care Policy and Financing as a Community Centered Board (CCB) to coordinate and deliver services to children and adults with IDD. Also, by contract with the Colorado Department of Human

Services, TRE is also the Early Intervention Service Provider for El Paso, Park and Teller counties. TRE's core strategy is to transform the life experiences of people with IDD by offering fully customizable, innovative services that: build independence, grow economic opportunity, and focus on exceptional health and welfare in order to grow quality of life. TRE partners with hundreds of human service provider agencies, school districts, and a host of additional corporate partners, from healthcare outlets, to local and regional private corporate, academic, research and healthcare organizations in the delivery of services locally, across Colorado, the United States, and abroad. Through this network, TRE can offer the highest quality choices of supports to people with IDD and their families to best meet their needs.

There are nearly 100 Parent Training and Information Centers (PTIs) and Community Parent Resource Centers (CPRCs) in the US and Territories. These Centers perform a variety of direct services for children and youth with disabilities, families, professionals, and other organizations that support them. They work with families of infants,

toddlers, children, and youth with disabilities, birth to 26, help parents participate effectively in their children's education and development, and partner with professionals and policy makers to improve outcomes for all children with disabilities. All the materials found on the CPIR Hub have been created and archived for Parent Centers around the country to help them provide support and services to the families they serve. Some of the resources available include family-friendly information and research-based materials on key topics and a twice-monthly e-newsletter with key topics and new resources.


