The City was founded in 1884. The Monte Vista Downtown Historic District that encompasses much of Monte Vista's downtown core is listed on the National Register of Historic Places, and the State Register of Historic Properties. Goals of the downtown district include expanding

economic vitality and preserving historic architectural character. Community leaders are pursuing creating a sustainable community from multiple levels, including economic development, community development, redevelopment, and affordable housing.
