## **Elk Hunters: Be Aware of Your Target!**

Moose can be found in the same habitat as elk in Colorado. Make sure vou know the difference between these two species, so you don't accidentally kill a moose. Use your binoculars, not scopes. Don't just look at the animal's antlers; study the entire head before you shoot.

# Elk & Moose Comparison



#### **Bull Elk**

- Slender snout
- Pale yellow rump
- Chestnut-brown neck
- Reddish, lighter brown body
- Darker legs
- Antlers not palmated
- Obvious brow tines coming off main beam.

#### **Cow Elk**

- Slender snout
- Pale yellow rump
- Chestnut-brown neck
- Reddish, lighter brown body
- Darker legs

# **Bull Moose**

- Dark, black-brown body
- · Overhanging snout, bulbous nose
- Larger bell (beard) on throat
- Whitish-gray legs
- Palmated antlers with tines

#### **Cow Moose**


- Dark, black-brown body
- Overhanging snout, bulbous nose
- Bell (beard) on throat
- Whitish-gray legs
