


Jackson Lake State Park Hunting Regulations

General Information:

1. Hunting for small game and waterfowl is permitted during established seasons, in areas of the park not posted against such use (see map), from the Tuesday after Labor Day to the Friday before Memorial Day.
2. Bows and arrows or shotguns loaded with birdshot no greater than T buck, are the only permitted methods of take. It is illegal to have lead shot in possession when waterfowl hunting.
3. Hunters are required to remain one hundred (100) yards from all buildings, trails and open campgrounds. Hunting is prohibited from the swim beaches.
4. It is unlawful for a person to carry a weapon when under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs. Only 3.2% alcohol is allowed on park property.
5. Any person entering upon private land for any purpose including retrieving downed wildlife **MUST** obtain permission from the landowner. Trespassing, while hunting, is a misdemeanor and if convicted could result in loss of hunting privileges. Shooting across fence lines is considered trespassing.

Waterfowl Hunting Regulations:

1. Hunting hours are one-half hour before sunrise to sunset.
2. Waterfowl hunters must use non-toxic shot. This includes steel, bismuth, iron tungsten and tungsten polymer loads. Lead shot is illegal and must not be on, or in the vicinity, while engaged in hunting.
3. All dogs must be leashed to and from the hunting area.
4. Open fires are not permitted except in designated fire pits in the campgrounds.
5. A valid Colorado hunting license with both the Federal and State waterfowl stamps, a valid HIP number, and hunter safety card must be in possession and available for inspection when hunting waterfowl.
6. All shotguns must be capable of holding a maximum of two (2) rounds in the magazine and one in the chamber. It is illegal to have a round in the chamber when it is in a vehicle.
7. Hunting from frozen surface is prohibited.

Special Note:

There is one blind located on the south end of the park for your use. (Refer to 2B on map.) Hunters are not restricted to this blind. Hunters must stay 100 yards from the OHV Trail. Hunters are encouraged to stay 50 yards from the fence lines.

Special Restrictions

(Refers to area marked with "3" on map)

1. Parking is at the Inlet parking area **ONLY**. All vehicles must have a valid park's pass. All roads on this property are closed to the public. Handicapped hunters may utilize the access road to get to and from the blind but need to park at the Inlet.
2. Hunting is permitted on Wednesday, Saturday, Sunday and legal holidays only.
3. There are three (3) pit blinds, one (1) wood blind and one (1) handicapped blind available on a first-come, first-served basis. The handicapped blind is for handicapped hunters only at all times.
4. All waterfowl hunting is restricted to the blinds only. Upland bird and small game may be hunted anywhere on the property.
5. All hunters must check-in at the check station sign located at the Inlet parking lot.
