

Regulations

1. No weekend hunting allowed! State Parks Regulations states hunting is only allowed Monday thru Friday, starting the Tuesday after Labor Day to the Friday prior to Memorial Day.
2. No discharging of explosives, fire arms, and/or weapons within 100 yds. of any designated picnic area, trail, or road.
3. No backcountry camping Sunday thru Thursday nights during hunting seasons.
4. A valid Parks Pass is required for all individuals and vehicles that enter the park.
5. All hunters must check in at the visitor center or at the self service station.
6. No target shooting.
7. You must report any harvest to a Park Ranger or on the hunter check in sheet at the self-service station.
9. Turkey hunting is allowed on Monday and Tuesdays only in the spring season.
8. Only 40 hunters will be allowed in the park at one time.
9. All other Division of Wildlife regulations apply.

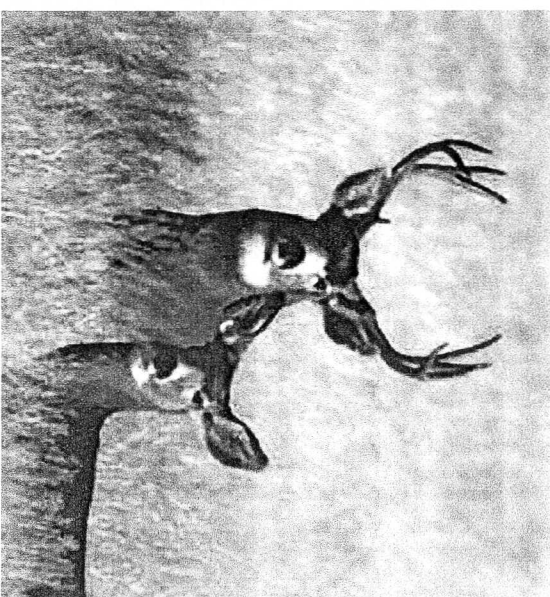

Hunting is Not allowed in the shaded areas on the map.

- Lory State Park is in D.O.W. Unit 19.
- The Park Opens at 5:00 a.m. and Closes at 10:00 p.m.
- The north, west, and south boundaries are fenced. **DO NOT** hunt beyond these fences.
- No hunting is allowed on Swanson Ranch or in Horsetooth Mountain Park.
- No hunting east of the main road and north of the posted orange diamond symbol.
